Verb to HAVE (*avere*).

Il verbo To HAVE ha il significato generale di *avere*.
Il verbo to Have è seguito dal GOT per sottolineare il senso di possesso e per descrivere le persone.

Affermative form

SINGULAR	I have (got)	<i>Io ho</i>
	You have (got)
	He haS (got)
	She haS (got)
	It haS (got)
PLURAL	We have (got)
	You have (got)
	They have (got)

Example:

I have got a brother.

Io ho un fratello.

She has got a sister.

Lei ha una sorella.

We have got blond hair.

Hanno i capelli biondi.

Espressioni con To HAVE.

To HAVE a bath = fare un bagno.

To HAVE a shower = fare una doccia.

To HAVE rest = riposare.

To HAVE a dream = fare un sogno.

To HAVE a nightmare = fare un incubo.

To HAVE a chat = fare una chiacchierata.

To HAVE a party = fare una festa.

To HAVE a look = dare un'occhiata.

To HAVE a cigarette = fumare una sigaretta.

To HAVE a dinner = cenare

To HAVE a lunch = pranzare

To HAVE breakfast = fare colazione

To HAVE a snack = fare uno spuntino

To HAVE a picnic = fare un picnic

To HAVE a coffee/ a tea = prendere un caffè/ tè

To HAVE a drink = prendere un drink.

To HAVE an holiday = fare una vacanza.

Per AUGURARE qualcosa:

HAVE a good trip = fate buon viaggio!

Have a good holiday/vacation= BUONA VACANZA!

Have a good lunch = Buon pranzo!

Have a good flight = Buon volo!

Have a good/nice day = Buona giornata!
